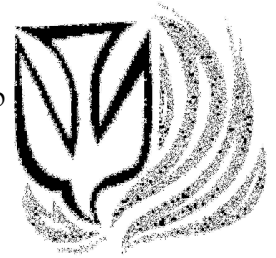
## *Prayers & Good Works for Haiti*
