Last week's school Open House events were a big success. We had a large number of families interested in sending their children to St. Ignatius School. Of special note is the tremendous interest in the new St. Ignatius Preschool that will be opening this coming September. Our plans are moving forward, and decisions have been made to offer preschool 5 days per week for 3-year olds through Kindergarten-ready, and to house the preschool classroom within the school building. We are currently developing the preschool curriculum and will be hiring teachers soon.

Our Catholic faith is at the heart of St. Ignatius School, and we've begun a new tradition that joins the school community in prayer each Friday morning.
